



FIRE SAFETY HOUSE

To Reserve:

1. E-mail FSHAACOUNTY@gmail.com at least 2 months in advance.
2. Provide contact person and info.
3. Provide names of persons trained in running the FSH (no less than 2 persons).
4. Provide date, times and location.
5. Provide name of operator hauling the FSH.

Transportation of FSH:

1. Provide vehicle (3/4 to 1 ton) heavy-duty truck.
2. Must have class 5 hitch.
3. Must have 7-pin cable for electrical hook-up.
4. Must have electrical brake controller.
5. Operator must be trained in the transporting of the FSH.

Rules for the FSH:

1. All operators are to be trained prior to use of FSH.
 - FSH operation (initial and event skill demonstration)
 - FSH transporting
2. Trained operator to remain inside the FSH at all times the FSH is in operation.
3. Under **no circumstance is food or drink allowed in the FSH.**
4. FSH must be returned to place of storage within 24 hours of use (station 18 Marley).
5. Contact person-in-charge of the FSH when FSH has been returned.
6. FSH must be returned in clean condition with all accessories placed back in compartments they came from both inside and outside the FSH.

TRAINING FOR FIRE SAFETY HOUSE

FSH Operators:

1. Must receive training in the use and care of the FSH prior to reserving.
2. Must demonstrate at an event with lead operator FSH operations competency.
3. Transportation operators must receive training in the proper way to hook up, use of stabilizing bars and hauling of FSH prior to reserving.

Training:

1. Training will be provided on a quarterly basis with the schedule put out in January of each year.
2. Training of all operators to be conducted by certified FSH personnel. Following training by certified personnel required to operate the FSH at an event with certified operator.
4. Certified operators names, date of training will be recorded to ensure accountability.
